**Re: Year 9 - Td/IPV/MenACWY & catch-up MMR**

There will be an immunisation session run by school nurses to vaccinate Year 9 students against Tetanus, Diphtheria, Polio (Td/IPV) Meningitis ACWY and catch up MMR for students who have not received two doses of MMR previously. These injections are part of a national immunisation programme. You are receiving this letter because your daughter is required to attend a session.

The sessions will be run on **Monday 13<sup>th</sup> January 2020**. Your daughter will be called over to the Drama Hall to have her vaccination.

The consent form for this vaccination will be given to your daughter to bring home shortly. Please complete and return the form to us before Friday 13<sup>th</sup> December. If your daughter is in need of a new form, please ask her to collect one from Student Support.

Those pupils in Year 9 who, according to the School Aged Immunisation Team records have an incomplete history of receiving Mumps, Measles and Rubella (MMR) vaccines, will be sent a MMR consent form to their home address which will arrive in a brown envelope. For your information, two doses of the combined (not singular) MMR vaccine are required to complete the course.
