## Year 12 English Trip An Importance of Being Earnest, Watermill Theatre, Newbury

I am writing to propose an exciting opportunity for your daughter to see the production of The Importance of Being Earnest on Friday 7<sup>th</sup> June 2019, 7.30pm at The Watermill Theatre in Newbury.

The tickets for this performance have been held for us at a reasonable price, however, we do need to secure them through payment as soon as possible.
