## Bethlem Museum, London

We are delighted to invite the Year 12 Psychology students to visit the Bethlem Museum of the Mind on **Monday** 10<sup>th</sup> February 2020.

Bethlem Museum of the Mind is a museum focusing on the history of Bethlem Royal Hospital, its programme of care, and its patients. The Museum of the Mind records the lives and experience and celebrates the achievements of people with mental health problems. This is useful for number of topics in Psychology A level, including psychopathology and schizophrenia. Opened in 2015, the museum is housed in an Art Deco building shared with the Bethlem Gallery, which hosts exhibitions of contemporary artists who are current or former patients.

We will depart school by coach at 0800 and return to school at approximately 1600.

We are asking for a voluntary contribution of £25.00 for this trip. This includes conference entry and travel to London.
