A Spectroscopy Masterclass has been organised for **Wednesday 26th June 2019** at Reading University. Students will be shown the instruments used in mass spectrometry, nuclear magnetic resonance (NMR) spectroscopy and infrared (IR) spectroscopy, and they will be given an opportunity to view them in action. They will also be able to review their understanding of these techniques during a series of short workshops on each. This will enhance their theory lessons on instrumental analysis and provide them with valuable experience on the use of these instruments.
