Re: Year 9 Bushcraft Trip – 17th June – 19th June 2020

We are delighted to offer Year 9 students the opportunity to spend time together on a three-day residential camping trip to The Bushcraft Company's site near Badminton in Gloucestershire. The aim of this trip is to strengthen bonds among the year group and to develop character in a gently invigorating environment. The students will be accompanied by Holt staff, but all activities will be led by trained instructors.

The trip will take place from 17th June – 19th June 2020 which will be during the school's activities week, when all students will be "off timetable". No lessons will therefore be missed by participation in this exciting trip.

About the trip

The three-day residential course will act as a fantastic step towards the development of leadership skills, demanding resourcefulness, decision-making and practical thinking from students. Each day will be made up of a range of hands-on workshops, offering a chance to really get to grips with life in the outdoors and providing a unique environment in which to learn and interact.

This experience is structured so that activities alternate between group discussions and practical elements, putting the skills taught into immediate use. The students will work in small groups of between ten and fifteen, each of which will be assigned a Bushcraft group leader, allowing every student the opportunity to really contribute to the collaborative effort required.

Time spent living in the wild offers a wonderful opportunity for students to interact away from the distractions of everyday school life, taking them out of their comfort zones and encouraging both independence and teamwork. By the end of the course, the students will have gained a far better understanding of the natural British landscape and they will leave with a new sense of self-sufficiency and confidence.

Activities are likely to include:-

- Campcraft
- Shelter building
- Night games
- Wilderness first aid
- Camouflage and concealment
- Cutting tools workshop
- Tribes got talent competition

Accommodation will consist of bell tents and permanent shelters. Toilets and washing facilities are provided.



We hope that the vast majority of Year 9 students will take up this opportunity. The total cost for this trip is £190.
