Granada Trip

As you are aware, your daughter is due to go on the Spanish trip to Granada on 19th -22nd March. In light of the outbreak of Coronavirus, I would like to update you on our current position.

As the Foreign and Commonwealth office (FCO) currently have no travel warnings in place for Spain, the trip will go ahead as planned.

Of course, this advice from the FCO may well change, and if it does we will update you accordingly.

You may decide however, to withdraw your daughter from the trip anyway, which of course is entirely your choice. However, please note our insurers may *not* unfortunately be able to offer refunds under these circumstances.

Should the advice from the FCO change and we have to cancel the trip, then our insurance will enable full refunds.

If any there are developments to Coronavirus whilst the trip is in progress, then the following contingencies, have been outlined by the Risk Protection Arrangement (RPA) part of our insurance policy.

If staff or pupils become ill with the Coronavirus or symptoms of the Coronavirus whilst on a trip overseas the RPA will provide indemnity for emergency medical expenses, change of itinerary, curtailment and rearrangement of travel plans. This is subject to the definitions, extensions, exclusions and conditions of the RPA membership rules.
