Dear Parent/Guardian

Re: Winter Uniform Reminders

We hope you have had a lovely summer and we are looking forward to welcoming your daughter/s back to school this week. Please find below a few reminders regarding the winter uniform that you may find helpful.

- Plain opaque navy blue or black tights must be worn in the Autumn and Spring term. Skin coloured or patterned tights, and white socks are not acceptable. However, given the warm weather, forecast to continue for the next two weeks, we will relax this rule until Friday 14th September, so that girls can wear navy or black ankle or trainer socks as an alternative.
- School shoes must be black leather or canvas. Boots, sliders, trainers and open toe sandals are not allowed.
- Year 7 and 8 students must wear their Holt navy blazers over their jumpers.
- T shirts should not be worn under school blouses.
- The only jewellery permitted is a wristwatch and one plain stud may be worn in each ear.
- If students have any other piercings, including nose studs, they will be asked to remove them and this includes retainers.
- Discreet, concealer make up is allowed. Mascara, lipstick, eyeshadow, eyebrow make-up or blusher are not allowed.
- We do not allow nail varnish or false nails to be worn in school.
- All students are required to tie their hair up where it is long enough to do so throughout the school day.
- Hairstyles which the school judge to be extreme (grade 1 or 2, shaved patterns and unnatural colours) are not allowed.
