RE: Year 10 - Set 19th Century text - The Strange Case of Dr. Jekyll and Mr. Hyde

The AQA Examining Board for English Literature advises us that candidates should annotate their set texts during the course to help prepare for the examination, which means considerable underlining and note making on the pages. We wish to enable our students to follow this essential practice, but you will appreciate that books with annotation cannot be passed on to future students.

Your daughter will be studying 'The Strange Case of Dr. Jekyll and Mr. Hyde' with her class teacher in the coming weeks. We are writing to ask parents if they would be prepared to make a voluntary contribution of **£6** this half term to help us provide your daughter with a copy of the text.
