Re: Year 11 Maths Study Day

During half term we are going to run a maths study day on **Tuesday 28th May from 9am to 1.30pm**. All students in Year 11 are invited to attend, although places will be allocated on a first-come, first-served basis. Some students who are identified as having the greatest need will also be selected from the waiting list.

There will be two sessions of two hours, with a break in between. In those sessions we will be looking at two predicted papers for the final two exams, based on what was on the first paper on Tuesday 21st May. Your daughter will have the opportunity to work through the paper and then the teacher will focus on the more demanding questions to ensure understanding. Where time allows, they will also look at other topics that the students may raise as issues from their revision.

Refreshments during the morning will be provided. Students do not need to wear uniform for the day but should ensure that they bring their mathematics equipment (including calculators). Students should come to the Humanities block.
