Re: Year 12 Set Texts – ‘The Importance of Being Earnest’ by Oscar Wilde and ‘Twelfth Night’ by William Shakespeare

The AQA Examining Board for English Literature advises us that candidates should annotate their set texts during the course to help prepare for the A level examination, which means considerable underlining and note making on the pages. In Year 12, part of the course will involve the study of the play ‘The Importance of Being Earnest’ by Oscar Wilde and ‘Twelfth Night’ by William Shakespeare.

We are writing to ask parents if they would be prepared to make a voluntary contribution to help us provide the relevant text for your daughter or son. The price we are able to offer is **£2.80** for ‘The Importance of Being Earnest’ and **£5.77** for ‘Twelfth Night.’

Of course, no student will be left without a book if a contribution is not made, but we would ask that in these circumstances the book be returned without any marking so it can be used again. Should this not be the case, we would have to ask for replacement costs.

If you are happy to make the voluntary contribution, payment for the text books should be made via WisePay; simply login to your WisePay account for details.
