Dear Parent/Guardian

Re: Year 12 Parents' Consultation Evening - Online Appointment Booking

I would like to invite you to attend our Parents' Consultation Evening on **Thursday 13th February**. Your daughter/son will be expected to attend the parents' evening, as the dialogue between the teacher, you and your daughter/son will ensure a consistent message, that everyone is part of and hears at the same time. In addition, the process will encourage your daughter/son to be reflective in their learning. We will be explaining to your daughter/son how to prepare for parents' evening and they should be considering the following:

- What do they think they are good at in each of their subjects?
- For each subject, what areas do they find difficult?
- Where do they think they can improve and how?

When you arrive, please sign in against your child's name and take a seating plan.

The school has an easy to use online appointment booking system. This allows you to choose your own appointment times with teachers and you will receive an email confirming your appointments. The appointments are either 5 or 10min slots (depending on class size) between 4.15pm and 6.45pm. We do not limit the number of appointments; however, some staff have more than one Year 12 class and do not have enough appointments to see everyone. The appointment system sets up a waiting list as soon as all slots have been booked. Once bookings are closed, if there are cancellations we will try our best to accommodate the waiting lists and will be in touch with parents affected.

Appointments can be made between **8pm Friday 31st January and 11pm Friday 7th February**. It is important that appointments are made as soon as possible. Should you wish to make any changes after this date please contact Mrs Calliss or Mrs Maynard on 0118 978 0165.
