WHY - To help prepare you for your GCSE options choices in February 2019.

WHEN - Choice 1 September to February halfterm

Choice February half-term until the end of the school year.

WHAT - Four material areas are offered you choose 2 only:-

Food and Nutrition Graphic Products Product Design Fashion & Textiles

Food & Nutrition

 You will build on your year 7 & 8 skills and focus on understanding the application materials and processes

We Introduce you to:-

- Faraway foods and food miles
- Food provenance
- Locally sourced foods
- Multi-cultural foods

and finally you will be given a practical test on all the knowledge gained throughout the course

Graphic Products

 You will focus on building your skills and gain an understanding of the materials and processes used in graphic products

We introduce you to:-

- Skills of communication through drawing and sketching
- Manufacturing processes of the graphics industry including printing processes

This is presented through mini projects using the iterative design process some examples are:-

- Design and make a case bound book
- Design promotional materials
- Produce an educational game
- Design & Print graphics onto ceramic mugs

and finally you will be tested on all the knowledge gained throughout the course

Product design

- You will focus on building your skills and gain an understanding of the materials and processes used in Product Design
- Manufacturing processes of wood, metal and plastic

Through mini projects using the iterative design process examples of some potential projects are:-

- Design & make a 3D Acrylic Clock
- Design a Speaker using moulded plastics
- Design & make Enamel Jewellery
- Design & make a mirror influenced by Post modern designers
- And finally you will be tested on all the knowledge gained throughout the course



You will build on your year 7 & 8 skills and focus on understanding the application materials and processes used in the Fashion & Textiles Industry

We Introduce you to:-

- Decorative techniques
- Dyeing processes
- Manufacturing processes of weaving, felting and knitting

All through mini projects using the iterative design process to various levels

• You will make a garment

and you will be tested on all the knowledge gained throughout the course
