**Re: Year 13 History – NEA letter**

I am contacting to inform you about some deadlines related to the non-exam assessed (NEA) component of the history A level to elicit that extra bit of parent support to ensure that your daughter remains on track. The NEA component consists of a 3500 word essay on a topic of their choice (this has already been chosen in June and the question decided in the past month).

At this stage your daughter should be in the process of writing her NEA. I have communicated to all history students taking history A level the following deadlines:

- Wed 20th December 2017: One full draft of the NEA to be submitted and marked over the Christmas and pre-public examination period. Feedback to be given in late January.
- Thursday 29th March 2018: Final deadline for the NEA to be completed by.

It is crucial that all pupils make a good effort at submitting a draft. We are legally only permitted to fully mark and give feedback on one full draft. If the draft is only partial then this will limit the range and quality of the feedback that we are able to give. Following the feedback your daughter will then have nearly a full term to make adjustments in time for the final deadline.
