## Re: Years 7-11 - Summer uniform rules letter

As we move into the summer term, here are a few reminders of the summer uniform rules:

- Navy or black ankle or trainer socks are allowed in the summer term as an alternative to plain
  opaque navy blue or black tights. Skin coloured or patterned tights, and <u>white socks</u> are not
  acceptable.
- School shoes must be black leather or canvas. Boots, sliders, trainers and open toe sandals are not allowed.
- Year 7 and 8 students must wear their Holt navy blazers over their blouses. There is no need for a jumper. We will email parents if the weather is too hot for blazers to be worn in school.
- T-shirts should not be worn under school blouses.
- The only jewellery permitted is a wristwatch, and one plain stud to be worn in each ear.
- If students have any other piercings, including nose studs, they will be asked to remove them and this includes retainers.
- Discreet, concealer make up is allowed. Mascara, lipstick, eyeshadow, eyebrow make up or blusher are not allowed. We have noticed that some students have begun to wear false eyelashes, which contravenes the uniform policy. If students do wear these to school, they will be asked to remove them.
- We do not allow nail varnish or false nails to be worn in school.
- All students are required to tie their hair up where it is long enough to do so throughout the school day.
- Hairstyles which the school judge to be extreme (grade 1 or 2, shaved patterns and unnatural colours) are not allowed.
