What is an Apprenticeship?














Who can do an apprenticeship?

There is no definitive answer.....

- ✓ Different entry requirements depending on occupation, level, sector, employer Apprer
- ✓ Must live in England
- ✓ Must not be in full time education
- ✓ Over 16 yrs there is no upper limit
- ✓ Committed to work and learning at the same time

Intermediate apprenticeship

- ·Level 2
- •12-18 months
- •Equivalent to 5 GCSEs A* - C

Advanced apprenticeship

- Level 3
- •18-48 months
- •Equivalent to 2 A-levels

Higher & degree apprenticeships

- •Levels 4,5,6,7
- •24 months+
- Equivalent to foundation degree level+




There are over 250 Apprenticeships frameworks and Standards covering over 1,500 job roles available.
